Sinnemahoning Creek Watershed Restoration Grants Available



The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission is accepting applications for up to \$100,000 for projects to restore the Sinnemahoning Creek Watershed due to pollution from a train derailment within the watershed in June. The PFBC's primary emphasis will be on projects in the Sinnemahoning Creek Watershed and upstream of the confluence with the First Fork of Sinnemahoning Creek. Applications are due Feb. 14.
