

STATE SENATOR WHITE VISITS PCEE

Slippery Rock, Pa. - State Senator Mary Jo White visited the Pennsylvania Center for Environmental Education's new office in Slippery Rock on Sept. 28 to check out its new reference library, other technology and upcoming initiatives.

The Senator toured the Main Street facility with Director Kathleen Paul and staff members. The in-house Environmental Reference Library and several learning technologies available at the Center were on display, along with exhibits highlighting upcoming initiatives.

Senator White procured funding for the formation of PCEE in 1997 and has continued to support the Center through legislation, including the current Senate Bill 410. The Pennsylvania Center for Environmental Education (PCEE) was created by Executive Order of the Governor in 1997 to "provide an avenue for increased participation of educators, local officials, citizen and non-profit groups, business and industry as partners in the implementation of quality environmental education on a state-wide basis." Administered by the PA State System of Higher Education, PCEE is housed at Slippery Rock University.
